What is ERA-NET?

- Action to coordinate research programmes across member/associated states
- Major players must fund/run national programmes
- Need at least three countries
- Long-term view, allow for different ways research is organised in different countries
- No restriction on topics bottom-up approach recommended to tap community enthusiasm
- 4 Oct deadline heavy competition expected
 - (early ERA-NETs will lead to major proposals)




ERA-NET & SW

- Identify SW activities outside ESA remit
 - So clearly in EU remit
 - Ground-based SW measurements
 - Large-scale numerical modelling of SW? e.g. global MHD, thermosphere/ionosphere
- Lobby appropriate national programmes
 - Tailor balance of SW apps and STP science as needed
- Critical to demonstrate enthusiasm of SW community

- Action to explore & report
- Meeting after SWWT?
- ERA-NETs seen as useful
 - Bottom-up approach good
- Nat hazards on political agenda
